- JD Steven Cobb and SW Todd Smith deepcleaned the Lodge kitchen, and even repaired the non-functioning half of our old-time oven.
- TR Mark Herzog got our industrial refrigerator repaired, saving the Lodge the expense of purchasing a replacement..
- JPM Al Florido, WM Billy Moreno and SW Smith installed improved lighting in the Lodge parking lot.
 We'll all feel much safer when the sun goes down!
- MS Scott Bulkley, SW Smith, MC Brad Ledbetter and EA Joey Hereford gave the outside of the Lodge building and our patio and walkways a much-needed power-washing. Thirteen years' worth of accumulated grime is gone!
- SD Gary Wiener obtained lettering to identify our building from the street, and a number of Brethren worked hard to help with installation. Take a look next time you drive by!

There are still improvements to be completed (and all members are encouraged to lend their time and assistance to these projects):

- WM Moreno plans to donate and install a sign marking the Lodge driveway, near the street, to make the Lodge entrance easier to identify.
- JPM Florido plans to replace our worn-out air conditioning units with new, more energy-efficient systems.
- The second floor of our Lodge building will be organized and finished out to make the space usable,

so that offices and "huddle rooms" will be available for candidate education, memory work, and other potential uses.
