The **Humphrey Benevolent Fund** was established from the bequest of the estate of Brother W. S. Humphrey to Gray Lodge in 1929, The property in the estate of Brother Humphrey was set aside by the membership of Gray Lodge as an endowment for charitable purposes, primarily to relieve the distresses of Gray Lodge Brethren and their wives, widows, mothers, sisters and daughters. In addition, the Fund may be used for appropriate Community Charity Projects.

Although many Brethren don't know about the Humphrey Fund, rest assured that the mission of its Administrative Board (composed of the five principal Elected Officers and two Brethren appointed at the Worshipful Master's discretion) is to provide emergency financial help when it is critically needed — no questions asked, no identities disclosed.

The gifts from the Humphrey Fund are just that — gifts — and the Fund does not require

nor expect to be reimbursed. However, that means that from time to time, the available cash in the Fund dips to an alarmingly low level. When that happens, it is up to those Brethren whose cable tow will permit to share their generosity, so that it can be put to best use when it is needed. IN MEMORIAM

Bro. Harry Joyce Green, Jr.

April 16, 1930 — December 12, 2022



Bro. Harry Joyce Green, Jr., son of our Past Master Harry J. Green, Sr., laid down his well-worn working tools on December 12, 2022. Bro. Green was born to Cecilia and Harry Sr. in 1930, and grew up in Houston, where he graduated from Stephen F. Austin High School in 1948.

He entered Texas A&M University in the fall of 1948, and would continue to be a loyal Aggie for the rest of his life. As a member of the Corps of Cadets, he was part of Company B, and was an intercollegiate track star in what was then the Southwest Conference. In mid-1950, when the Korean Conflict broke out, Cadet Green left A&M to enlist in the U.S. Navy, serving for four years. Occasionally he would return to Houston, where he was initiated as an Entered Apprentice Mason in Gray Lodge No. 329 on July 30, 1951; passed to the degree of Fellowcraft on March 26, 1952; and raised to the Sublime Degree on May 28, 1952. Bro. Green was discharged in March 1955, when he

returned to A&M to complete his Bachelor of Science degree in Industrial Education.

After graduation, he moved back to Houston, where he worked as a safety engineer in waste management and distributor for Honda motorcycles. He became active in the Houston A&M Club, and later helped start its Southwest Houston Chapter. Harry served as a Co-Class Agent for the Class of 1952 for many years .

Because of his visibility in Houston, Bro. Green was the perfect candidate to be chosen as the first Field Director for the Association of Former Students, whose growth potential would require greater statewide participation among fellow former students. Equipped with a company car and persuasive speaking skills, Bro. Green quickly came to know virtually every other Aggie in the state.

In 1980, Bro. Green married his beloved wife, Nelda. Together they lived an active and rewarding life until Nelda's passing in October 2017.

Harry Green's name is synonymous with the Aggie Club, the permanently-endowed athletic scholarship program, as he became its Executive Director in 1979. A 2012 interview in the *12th Man Magazine* noted that in 1975 there were approximately 1200 members with revenues about \$275,000. By the time Bro. Green retired in 1992, the newly renamed "12th Man Foundation" had 6,500 members and millions in revenues.

Bro. Danny Harold Fuller, Sr.

November 22, 1940 — January 13, 2023

Bro. Danny H. Fuller Sr., Marshal of Gray Lodge No. 329 in 2009-2010, went to be with the Supreme Architect of the Universe on January 13, 2023. He was initiated May 8, 1985; passed Aug. 7, 2008; and raised Oct. 16, 2008, all in Gray Lodge. Bro. Fuller became an Endowed Member on June 20, 2011.

Bro. Fuller led a very private life, particularly after the passing of his son and our Brother, Danny H. Fuller, Jr. in 2022. He is survived by his wife, Carmelita. All funeral plans and other final arrangements were kept private.

IN MEMORIAM

Bro. Robert Shearn Smith, PM

October 8, 1927 — January 17, 2023



The Monitor of the Grand Lodge of Texas quotes Psalms 90:10: "The days of our years are three score and ten,' and 'if by reason of strength they be four score years,' the additional days are the heritage of those who fear the name of the Lord. Our Brother and Past Master, Judge Shearn Smith, lived nearly five score years before laying down his working tools on January 17, 2023, at the age of 95.

A native Houstonian, Bro. Shearn followed his older brother, Jackson B. Smith, Jr., into the U.S. Armed Forces and into Gray Lodge No. 329, being initiated on Oct. 11, 1950, passed Feb. 26, 1951, and raised Oct. 1, 1951. He also followed his brother, not only onto the Harris County bench in 1968, but through the line of our

Lodge, leading to his service as Worshipful Master during Gray's centennial in 1969-70.

Bro. Shearn should not, however, be seen only in his brother's shadow. In 1983 he began a lifetime of service to the Grand Lodge of Texas, serving on the Grievance & Appeals Committee No. 1 under Grand Master J.D. "Buddy" Baccus. He served seven Grand Masters on (what was then called) the Titles, Deeds and Civil Law Committee from 1993-1999 and again in 2000, and was our District Deputy Grand Master under R : W : Billy W. Tinsley in 1994. Bro. Smith also served as District 30-B's Education Officer from 1994-1998; as Grand Chaplain for R : W : Michael D. Nanny in 2002; and as a member of the Masonic Jurisprudence Committee from 2002-2008. For his efforts on behalf of Texas Masonry and particularly Gray Lodge, our conference room and library is dedicated in his honor.

Bro. Shearn met the love of his life, Annell, in April 1954 at a State Bar Convention at the old Shamrock Hilton. Together they raised four children: twin boys Ronald and Donald, who survive him; and Cheryl and Robert Jr., who predeceased him.

Bro. Shearn was in the second graduating class of the Univ. of Houston Law School in 1951 (one year behind Bro. Jack Smith), and was elected to the 61st District Court bench in 1968, where "Stern Shearn" remained until his retirement in 1996. Among his accomplishments was to overhaul the jury selection system in Harris County, replacing the physical "jury wheel" (which contained about 111,000 jurors' names) with an electronic system (expanding the potential jury pool to over 2.5 million).

His proudest accomplishment after his family, however, may have been when he became president of the UH Alumni Association, and sang the National Anthem and Alma Mater at all football and basketball games from 1968 to 2015. (He was also known to break into song within our lodge room on occasion!)

Bro. Smith's funeral was on January 26, 2023, with his Gray Lodge brethren providing Masonic rites. He was laid to rest in a private ceremony at the Texas State Cemetery in Austin, near his (and our) brother Jack. The family asks memorial donations be made to Faith Lutheran Church in Bellaire; Shearn Smith UH Band Scholarship; Shearn Smith UH Law Scholarship; and Judge Shearn Smith Masonic Library at Gray Lodge No. 329.
